In planning for the next phase of this pandemic, my team and I have reviewed the recommendations on mask for the K-12 setting from experts across the country. I would like to propose the following metrics as CDPH is planning for the K-12 Mask mandate off- and onramp:

- Overall hospitalization rate.
